What We Do

The Giving Tree provides educational giving opportunities for today's youth. Through events open to the public as well as private service programs, The Giving Tree is able to offer a charitable connection for children and teens.



1,127 handmade cards were made for the elderly, individuals experiencing homelessness, kids in hospitals, our US military and local police & fire personnel.

Who Are We Helping?

The Giving Tree delivered over 16,100 gifts to over 130 nonprofits in the tri state area in 2017.

We delivered 1,600 bags of school supplies to children in underprivileged schools.



9,469 gifts of snacks, socks and toiletries went to homeless and poverty-stricken individuals.
