Who Are We Helping?

The Giving Tree delivered over 19,201 gifts to over 158 nonprofits in the tri state area in 2018.

We delivered 1,899 bags of school supplies to children in underprivileged schools.



10,648 gifts of snacks, socks and toiletries went to homeless and poverty-stricken individuals.



Some benefiting nonprofits include: Meals on Wheels, hospitals, social service organizations, soup kitchens and food pantries, Boys & Girls Clubs, Operation Gratitude, Ronald McDonald Houses, SPCA, local senior centers and more.

2,559 projects benefitted elderly individuals of Philadelphia, Montgomery & Bucks Counties.
