When? Anytime during the month of January 2022.

What? The MLK Challenge is an opportunity to bring a meaningful community service project to your group or school. We are challenging YOU to create Sock Rolls for those experiencing homelessness. A Sock Roll is a pair of men's athletic /crew socks that is rolled with a granola bar and a pack of crackers and finished off with a ribbon and a tag from a student.

Where? Our volunteers will work with you to get the materials to your school or location.

Why? Socks tend to be the number one requested item by individuals experiencing homelessness. This project brings warmth, some comfort and nourishment for those in need. This is also a wonderful opportunity to teach your students the importance of helping others and 'giving back' to our community.

- 2 winners will be chosen from 2 categories: A) 50 students or less. B) 51 students or more.
